WHY FUNDRAISE?

-The annual operational budget to be a team in the FIRST program is approximately \$60 000.

While we do get some money from sponsors, donors and team membership fees, it is not enough to cover the full cost.

HOW IS THE MONEY SPENT?

(1) REGISTRATION FEES-\$18 000

-Regional tournament fees for two events \$7500

-Ontario Championship fee \$3500

-World Championship fee \$7000
