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POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

- Participants must follow all safety rules as taught and published.
- All people must wear safety glasses and wear safety shoes in the facility.
- All eligible persons entering the robotics facility must show proof of receiving their COVID-19 vaccinations.
- All those attending meetings must complete the pre-meeting COVID screening.
- Masks must be worn for indoor meetings.
- Where possible, a distance of 2 metres between participants must be maintained.
- A participant who develops symptoms of COVID-19 must not attend in-person meetings until cleared by a medical professional or public health instructions.
- A Director of the organization must be informed if a participant tests positive for COVID-19.
- Only one person is permitted in a washroom at one time.
- · Participants must wash their hands regularly.
- Participants attending a meeting must sign in and out of the meeting in the provided logbook or application.
- Guidelines provided by Kingston Frontenac Lennox and Addington Public Health and the Limestone District School Board may change. The Team will do its best to keep participants informed.
